

## OMAGH ENHANCED LOCAL HOSPITAL.

---

McLaughlin & Harvey are delighted to have been awarded the contract for the construction of Omagh Enhanced Local Hospital. This is the first edition in the series of our project Newsletters. These will provide regular progress and update information. We hope you enjoy being updated on the project.

### Progress Report

---

The project is in the initial phases of construction, only having begun in mid – July. To date activity has been predominantly earthwork based. The topsoil has been stripped from the site area and excavations to formation level commenced. Surface water drainage has been incorporated to contain and deal with the storm water on the site. A settlement pond has been constructed to the North of the site to capture the water prior to it being released into the Camowen River.

The area designated for the main site set up is being established adjacent to the entrance on the Donaghane Road. These site offices will be completed by October. A temporary site office set up is being used at present.

Hoarding around the site perimeter has been erected and this will be decorated in partnership with the Trust within the coming weeks.



### Community / Environmental issues

---

We are aware of the potential impact on the local area and will actively work with the local community and the Trust to ensure that appropriate and timely measures are introduced to minimise any potential disruption during the development.

A pre-start letter was distributed to the local residents directly affected by the works which included information on the construction start date. Progress information will be continued through a series of monthly newsletters.

As schools are returning currently returning from their holiday period McLaughlin & Harvey and the Trust hope to get actively involved with the schools in the community over the duration of the hospital project.

In order to facilitate the construction of the hospital, a significant amount of material will have to be removed off site. As a result of this removal process, traffic movement will be increased around the site area. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused.
