Having been awarded the contract for Omagh Enhanced Local Hospital, McLaughlin & Harvey have the project well underway. These regular edition newsletters will provide progress and update information. We hope you enjoy being updated on the project.

Progress Report

The site is becoming increasingly busy with approximately 130no. operatives onsite daily. Underground storm and foul drainage is progressing well site wide whilst we are casting sections of ground floor slabs to various blocks almost weekly. The external brickwork has commenced to blocks A, F & C while the cladding is progressing in blocks G & H. Looking forward we hope to commence the first floor precast installation along with progressing the ground floor slabs and perimeter concrete walls.



Community / Environmental issues

We are aware of the potential impact on the local area and will actively work with the local community and The Western Health and Social Care Trust to ensure that appropriate and timely measures are introduced to minimise any potential disruption during the development.

McLaughlin and Harvey have incorporated numerous environmental aspects within the construction phase. We are dedicated to carrying out the construction works in the most sustainable manner possible.

A set of construction toys has been donated to the WHSCT Dental Department for children to use in the waiting room. The staff were very grateful for the gifts and we hope the children enjoy them.



To continue our relationship with the South West College in Omagh, another group of students have visited the site for a tour. The Foundation Degree Civil Engineering students were escorted around the site by Project Manager Robert Quinn where he explained the current works taking place and the constraints and challenges of the site.

We hope the students found this useful and look forward to further visits from the college.

The site is registered for the 2015 phase of works with the Considerate Constructor's Scheme which is a national initiative set up by the Construction Industry to improve its image. The project underwent a visit by a CCS monitor on the 13th March and achieved another impressive score of 43/50.
