Having been awarded the contract for Omagh Enhanced Local Hospital, McLaughlin & Harvey have the project well underway. These regular edition newsletters will provide progress and update information. We hope you enjoy being updated on the project.

Progress Report



Works are progressing at a rapid pace with significant progress being made weekly. 70% of the ground floor slab has been cast with the construction of the ground to first floor perimeter concrete walls progressing to blocks B & F with the perimeter walls complete to blocks C & A. Underground drainage will be complete under the floors by the end of April with the external main drainage progressing as required. Brickwork and cladding is continuing to progress wherever possible and the construction of the main car parks is due to commence in May/ June as the weather improves.

Community / Environmental issues

We are aware of the potential impact on the local area and will actively work with the local community and The Western Health and Social Care Trust to ensure that appropriate and timely measures are introduced to minimise any potential disruption during the development.

McLaughlin and Harvey have incorporated numerous environmental aspects within the construction phase. We are dedicated to carrying out the construction works in the most sustainable manner possible.

Members of the McLaughlin and Harvey team and Omagh and Altnagelvin are attending an event in sponsorship of the CIOB Annual Dinner and Student Awards Presentation.
