Progress Report



We have recently installed precast concrete slabs to the roof areas in blocks A,B,C & F which are now virtually complete. Roof slabs will then commence in block E. Plant room steelworks are complete in block C with steel works to commence in blocks B & F next week. Internal fit out works, stud partition walls and M&E works are progressing well in block G & H to begin shortly in block C. External brickwork is

progressing well site wide and car park construction is to be progressed in the coming weeks.
