Having been awarded the contract for Omagh Enhanced Local Hospital, McLaughlin & Harvey have the project well underway. These regular edition newsletters will provide progress and update information. We hope you enjoy being updated on the project.

Progress Report



Work is progressing steadily on site with approximately 350 operatives on site daily. We have recently poured the last section of concrete on the second floor roof and are currently in the process of completing the final steel framed plant room to Block D. The cladding and roofing is being carried out to the plantrooms in Block C, B, A and F with the main roofing works being carried out to Blocks C & B.

Plasterboard partitions are being installed to Blocks A, B, C and F alongside the installation of mechanical and electrical services. Window installations are virtually complete in Blocks B, C and F. Car park construction is continuing to car parks 2&3.

Coming up to the Christmas period we would like to wish the surrounding community and businesses Seasons Greetings and a Happy New Year.

We are aware of the potential impact on the local area and will actively work with the local community and The Western Health and Social Care Trust to ensure that appropriate and timely measures are introduced to minimise any potential disruption during the development.

McLaughlin & Harvey have incorporated numerous environmental aspects within the construction phase. We are dedicated to carrying out the construction works in the most sustainable manner possible.
