Having been awarded the contract for Omagh Enhanced Local Hospital, McLaughlin & Harvey have the project well underway. These regular edition newsletters will provide progress and update information. We hope you enjoy being updated on the project.

Progress Report

Works are continuing to progress throughout all blocks onsite with between 150-170 operatives daily. The main focus of works currently is first floor slabs with the first floors in blocks B, C and F already poured. Preparation for the second floor in block C will begin within the coming 4 weeks. Steel framed blocks G and H are being prepared for the mechanical and electrical fit out aspect to begin in August. Work is also beginning in car park areas with kerbing taking place in car park 3 at the moment. Excess material is continuing to be transported offsite.



Community / Environmental issues

We are aware of the potential impact on the local area and will actively work with the local community and The Western Health and Social Care Trust to ensure that appropriate and timely measures are introduced to minimise any potential disruption during the development.

McLaughlin & Harvey have incorporated numerous environmental aspects within the construction phase. We are dedicated to carrying out the construction works in the most sustainable manner possible.
