Having been awarded the contract for Omagh Enhanced Local Hospital, McLaughlin & Harvey have the project well underway. These regular edition newsletters will provide progress and update information. We hope you enjoy being updated on the project.

Progress Report

Works are progressing at a steady pace on site with over a 150 site workers on site daily. The main activity on site at present is the construction of the concrete frame and floor slabs to Blocks A - F. We have recently poured the 1st section of 1st floor to block C with more sections of floor to follow in the coming weeks. The ground floor has been completed apart from a section on Block D which will be cast by the middle of June. The removal of the large stockpile of excess clay off site has commenced which will take approximately 3 months.



Community / Environmental issues

We are aware of the potential impact on the local area and will actively work with the local community and The Western Health and Social Care Trust to ensure that appropriate and timely measures are introduced to minimise any potential disruption during the development.

McLaughlin and Harvey have incorporated numerous environmental aspects within the construction phase. We are dedicated to carrying out the construction works in the most sustainable manner possible.
